Adult and Pediatric CPR/First Aid/AED (Lay Responder) is the basic level course incorporating the latest science and teaches to recognize and care for a variety of first aid emergencies, as well as how to respond to breathing and cardiac emergencies to help victims of any age.

Staff Senate in conjunction with Rec Well will offer American Red Cross courses taught by experience instructors, which include online learning, in-person lectures, videos, demonstrations, practice, and testing skill scenarios. Upon successful completion of the course, participants will receive a certification that is valid for two years.
