
Staff Governance and Representation in the UNC System



UNC Board of Governors

The BOG is the policy making body charged with "the general determination, control, supervision, management, and governance" of the University of North Carolina system. Its 28* voting members are elected by the North Carolina General Assembly for four-year terms.

UNC System President

The President of the System reports to the Board of Governors.



UNC System Office

UNC System Office staff report to the President (and thus through the President to the BOG) and are responsible for working with campuses to implement policies approved by the BOG and regulations approved by the System President.



UNC System Staff Assembly

Established in 2006 under System President Erskine Bowles, the UNC System Staff Assembly is an advisory body to the UNC System President on behalf of the SHRA and EPS Employees who represent the staff of the UNC System's 17 constituent institutions.

Members and the Chair of the NC State Staff Senate serve as delegates to the Staff Assembly, representing the interests of NC State's staff.

The Staff Assembly serves in parallel function with the University Faculty Assembly and the Association of Student Governments to address the concerns and interests of individual institutions and the System.

UNC Greensboro

UNC Greensboro is a constituent institution of the UNC System. According to UNC Code, the University of North Carolina at Greensboro has a board of trustees composed of thirteen persons: eight are elected by the UNC Board of Governors, two are appointed by the Speaker of the North Carolina House of Representatives, two appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the North Carolina Senate, and the remaining member is the president of the student body, ex officio.

UNCG Staff Senate

Established at the request of the Chancellor, The Staff Senate is charged with representing the university's SHRA and EHRA nonfaculty employees in an advisory capacity to the Chancellor and the UNC Staff Assembly.
